8. Upcoming Events/Calendars for November/ December 2016 and Flyers. Flyers and Calendars were sent via email to Commission.
Director Sosnowski gave information on The 2nd Annual Winter Break Kick-Off presented by Afterschool Recreation Program event taken place at the Cathy Hensel Youth Center. Reggie and Holifield park will also be having holiday events during winter vacation. Commission was given updated pamphlets on Senior Center facility and activities and events going on.

9. Special Projects. Military banner Project- Director Sosnowski stated the banners honor all local living or deceased Service men and women, decorated up and down Whittier Blvd and Montebello Blvd.

This would be a great opportunity for commission to be a part of to honor our Veterans. Fundraising would be needed to fund special project.

Chairperson Calland would be in support of project.

Commissioner Garcia also in support of project, Garcia asked how long the previous banners lasted.

Director Sosnowski stated the banners lasted up to 18 months. Director Sosnowski suggested working we order higher quality material & Framing would be ideal for banners to last longer. This would be an ongoing project and Banners would need to be replaced about every 2 years, it would be disrespectful to leave torn and tattered banners up disrespecting our Veterans.

Commissioner Garcia was in favor to proceed with project.

Commissioner Fimbres was in favor to proceed with project. Fimbres would like to fundraise and aims to tie the Military Banners along with the Vietnam Memorial Wall put up in April 2017.

Commissioner Beas was also in favor to proceed with project. Beas asked how this project will be done and what the amount of banners will be needed to post up.

Director Sosnowski gave an estimate of about 200 Banners needed. The Commissioners can decide if banners will be hung up seasonally or yearly.

Commissioner Diaz was also in favor to proceed with project.

Roll call vote: All commissioners voted in favor in adopting Military Banner Project as an official Culture and Recreation Commission project.

11. Annual Snow in the Park event will be held on December 10th, from 11:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. at Montebello City Park. There will be a Live Band, jumpers, face painting, games, pictures with Santa, an Ugly Sweater contest, Raffle prizes, and Food & Craft Vendors. Recreation staff will be working with a new snow company and making the snow area larger to accommodate the popularity and long lines and have an additional snow area.

12. Arts & Culture Committee Art project- A project to highlight local artist in City Hall. Director Sosnowski asked Commissioner Diaz and Vice-Chairperson Beas to stay after to set up a meeting date, and have information on event at next meeting.
13. Cheer Program- Director Sosnowski stated that the residents deserve to have access to affordable programs. Sosnowski provided photos of cheer program at different events they have performed at. Performances included the City's Halloween event, City Parade, flag football games and performing with Montebello High school Cheer team. These moments mean the world to parents and participants. There is a \$50.00 Registration fee, and a one-time fee of \$58.00 for uniform, unless child grows out of uniform or loses it. Sign-ups for new season will begin December 5th, 2016.
14. Upcoming sports program- Youth basketball is \$45 per child for children ages 3-17 years old. The program will be expecting 400 applicants this year. Staff will be utilizing and expanding program to Reggie and Holifield Parks. Annual Spring/ early summer Soccer Program registration will begin on March 30th. This spring we will also be adding a Track and Field team for each park. This summer will be adding Baseball for the first time at City, Reggie and Holifield Parks. This program will not interfere with other programs during the summer. In the fall there will be the normal Flag football season and sports staff will be introducing volleyball.
15. Veterans Day Recap- Director Sosnowski stated that there was a great turn out with live music and Speakers.

Chairperson Calland commented that the event was well attended with a Great Key note speaker and music. She would like to thank Director Sosnowski on doing a great job.
